Sub: Scheme for Financial Assistance to Youth Clubs

This is regarding financial assistance to around ten thousand Youth Clubs @ Rs.5,000/- per Club to encourage them to take up their activities in a better manner. In this connection the discussions made on 7th September'2011 in the Collector's Conference chaired by Hon'ble Chief Minister, Orissa may kindly be referred.

2. It is proposed to give Grants to Youth Clubs covering all 6231 GPs of the State. While One Youth Club will be considered for normal Districts, for naxal affected Districts, two youth Clubs will be considered. For 4140 GPs of 19 Naxal affected Districts 8290 Youth Clubs to be assisted. Similarly For 2091 GPs of Non-Naxal affected Districts, 2091 Youth Clubs are to be assisted. As such a total number of 10371 Youth Club are to be assisted.

3. This Grant would enable the Clubs to take up their activities in a better manner in the field of sports, character and nation building activities, seminars, adventure sports camps, purchase of sports equipments etc.

4. A Copy of the Scheme is enclosed herewith

5. It is requested that selection of Youth Clubs may be initiated right away and the selected GP-wise list of Youth Clubs along with details of their Bank Account may be submitted by 20th October'2011 for sanction and release of Grants.

FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO YOUTH CLUBS

Objective:

This is regarding financial assistance to ten thousand Youth Clubs @ Rs. 5,000/- per Club to encourage them to take up their activities in a better manner. This Grant would enable the Clubs to take up their activities in a better manner in the field of sports, character and nation building activities, seminars, adventure sports camps, purchase of sports equipments etc.

Eligibility Criteria:

- a. The Youth Club must be a Village / Panchayat based organization.
- b. Be a registered society with 3 years in existence with its registered office in the said Panchayat.
- c. Majority of the members should be from the same village / Panchayat.
- d. Majority of the members should be between the age group of 15-35 year.
- e. The Youth Club membership should be open to all.
- f. The Youth Club conducts meeting on time and maintain record and proceeding properly.
- g. Youth Club is associated with community development programmes.
- h. Must have an operative bank account.

Selection Process:

- a. It is proposed to give Grants Youth Clubs covering all 6231 GPs of the State. While One Youth Club will be considered for normal Districts, for naxal affected Districts, two youth clubs will be considered. For 4140 GPs of 19 Naxal affected Districts 8290 Youth Clubs to be assisted. Similarly for 2091 GPs of Non-Naxal affected Districts, 2091 Youth Clubs are to be assisted. As such a total number of 10371 Youth Clubs are to be assisted. The District-wise list of Youth Clubs to be assisted under the Scheme is at Annexure-A.
- b. Collectors to prepare the list of youth clubs operating in their District.
- c. In case of more number of applicants, the oldest registered youth club will be eligible for these Grants for this year.
- d. The youth club receiving Grant for a particular year will not be eligible for Grants for the next years till all the remaining Clubs are covered.
- e. The selection and screening of the eligible beneficiaries clubs may be made at block / district Level and the final selection list along with the bank account details of the club in the completed format be sent to the State for sanction and disbursement.
- f. The Grants will be transferred directly to the Bank Accounts of the selected Clubs. The details as Name of the Bank / Address / Account Number / Name of the operator of the Account / IFSC / RTGS Code of the Bank are to be mentioned while submitting the list of eligible GP-Wise list of Youth Clubs.
